PRUDENTIAL CORNER

We have made significant withdrawals from our investment account in the 2022 calendar year. On January 1, 2022, our investment account was worth \$441,000. Since that time, we have taken out \$47,950 to cover expenses and for the work done on the steeple. This coupled with the downturn in the market (\$18.39/share down to \$16.04/share) leaves our investment account worth \$345,000 as of June 20, 2022. Note that while most stock market indices are down ~20+% (ie. S&P 500, Dow Jones, and Nasdaq), our holdings are only down 12%.
