Dear Friends –

The liturgical season of Lent starts on March 6th. During the season of Lent, Christians often choose to pick up a specific spiritual discipline. Some of us take up new activities, like a Lenten Bible study or prayer practice. Others engage in the ancient, spiritual disciplines of fasting.

People fast from food altogether for a period of time or from a particular kind of food. The purpose, of course, is to allow God to fill those spaces in ourselves that would otherwise be filled from that from which we are fasting. Instead of a handful of potato chips (or a bag full) to quell the anxiety or emptiness within, turn to God instead.

- Fast from words and be silent so you can listen.

What a difference we would see in our lives and our world if we could observe just one of the disciplines suggested above. I offer them to you for your prayerful consideration this Lent.

This is an opportunity to live into the promises we make at every baptism – helping the children grow in Christ. Please reach out to Jess or Sondra.


