It's actually been getting harder for me to make myself go out. As I look at the church events calendar for March, I see that it is sparse. The image that comes to my mind is the life cycle of a butterfly/caterpillar.

I wonder if this March will be like the chrysalis stage for us as a congregation. The Transition Team has decided to pause for the month. It seems that right now, most in the congregation are just not in a mental state to participate in the vital activities that make for a positive transition. We are stressed in ways we haven't experienced before, and we are tired. Many members will be getting their vaccines this month which leads to yet more decisions. We are holding our collective breath that the vaccine will be successful. We want to gather in person; we want our children to go to school safely. The hope is great, but we don't want to be too hopeful just yet. We are happy for Eileen as she prepares to move and wonder, how will we possibly find an adequate replacement. Our anxiety is mounting. And so, we need this month to breathe deeply and work through the anxiety. We crave spring, literally and figuratively.

The Spirit in me, greets the Spirit in you, as we pathfind side-by-side on the way to Easter. May God bless us as we emerge from winter and the pandemic as changed people.

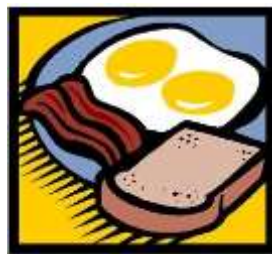
