## From the Music Director

In 2020, we thought we were having a very different Easter, and it was. We weren't in the sanctuary with lilies and tulips. The choir wasn't there in their robes, in fact we had no music. At least none that I recall. But, through the magic of the internet, we did have a service that Rev. Nathans conducted on a card table in her living room.

We were all in a state of disbelief and confusion. What would this mean for us going forward? Would we all be trying to learn programs that made it possible to at least see one another? How long would we be worshiping this way? Surely this couldn't last very long...

But, it did. We have adapted to Sunday morning services on Zoom. Zoom has been around since 2008, but was used primarily for business. However, it met most of our needs except unison readings and singing together.

More solutions were found, Zoom instruction videos and meetings became a large part of our lives. I'd like to say it was easy, but it wasn't. Recordings of scripture and prayer were made and sent to Rev. Geary, I recorded some hymns and she inserted them into the Sunday Worship Service. We all scrambled to get the service heard outdoors when summer came and we continued to stumble and fall, get up and try again, and learn.

Our Becki Abalutzk became the song leader and by Christmas we were able to make a small recording of carols with several choir members.

Now a year later, we are still on Zoom and You Tube. In almost every service there has been a glitch and we have learned that that's just the way it is. We are not professional sound engineers and it's stressful when you record at home with phones ringing, deliveries being made – lots of interruptions just when you thought you were getting a perfect recording. And so another attempt is made – sometimes it's the 6th or 7th attempt. And we learn and are humbled. Yet, I celebrate the support of all concerned. All of you who have tuned in and listened and been generous in your positive comments. Thank you.

Soon we will be able to be together and we will continue to build on what we have. Our church, our choir, our congregation – we are the church.


