Interim Pastor's Message

Path finding

Last May you invited me to join you in the wilderness. Together we have been living through unknown territory. We have had moments of wandering and moments of clear direction but here we are, still living in the not-anymore but not-quite-yet.

Some of the gospel writers tell us that right after Jesus was baptized, he spent 40 days in the wilderness preparing to begin his ministry. We are about to enter the 40 days of Lent wishing we had spent just 40 days in this wilderness of Corona Virus. Jesus faced many challenges and tests during his wilderness days and came out of it a changed person. We, as individuals and as the church, will come out of this wilderness changed also.

On Epiphany Sunday we each received our "star word". We also chose a word for the congregation. That word is "Pathfinding". I invite us, together, to use the upcoming season of Lenten as a time of intentional pathfinding. What path or paths will we take to move us out of the wilderness to a time when we feel like the ground isn't constantly shifting below us? What paths are God clearing for us to take? What brambles must we cut away for us to see the path? What stumbling stones must we move? What must we put in our backpacks to take along for this journey into the future?

M & M's Help Spread Message of Hope, Healing & Peace Through Donations to KNITTING4PEACE

Several members of the M & M's (Monday Morning) knitting group took a break after creating items for the Jolly Holly Fair recently to make items for Knitting4Peace. This is a Denver-based organization whose mission is "dedicated to crafting **hope, healing, & peace** one stitch at a time through nonviolent compassionate action. Knitting4Peace is dedicated to knitting together the global Beloved Community. We do our work one person at a time...one stitch at a time...one delivery at a time...one day at a time. The tangible items we create are personally delivered to women, teens, children, infants and families in global areas of conflict, including our own neighborhoods and countries around the world."



Since its founding in June 2006, the organization has delivered requested handmade items to more than 190,083 people living in communities across the United States and 82 countries around the world.

In the past, M & M's have donated just Peace Pal dolls, but this time we sent a variety of items, including Peace Pal dolls, Baby Peace Pal dolls, washcloths, baby bibs, warm hats and mittens, and baby booties. There is an intentional element of **three** in all the projects, which symbolizes the person who creates the project, the person who receives it, and the Mystery of Creation that creates and unites all of Creation.

Items we made might have had three colors, or contained three stitches, and were made in multiples of three. Three also represents the importance of the Abrahamic faith traditions to global peace. These three traditions (Judaism, Christianity, Islam) represent two-thirds of the world's population, so until our Abrahamic Family is knit together, there is virtually no hope for global peace.

"As we knit, crochet, weave, or quilt each item, we pray for each other; we pray for the recipients of the items we create; we pray for those who deliver our items; and we pray for hope, healing and peace throughout our world."


