Paul Rice submitted to the Mission committee a need from the Africa Exchange Project. He is a member of their Board of Directors. Africa Exchange Project is a nonprofit focused on improving the maternal healthcare in the village of Pomerini, Tanzania. Tanzania has one of the highest numbers of maternal deaths in the world.

The Africa Exchange Project's past efforts include equipping the clinic with new sterilizer and oxygen concentrator, new hospital beds and their first electrical connection. They are asking us to supply a ultrasound machine, which will provide avenues to diagnose congenital anomalies. The missions and council reviewed the request and approved \$6800.00 for the ultrasound. More information on this organization and their needs will be presented on a TBA Sunday service.
